DID YOU KNOW?

Novi Sad is the second largest city in Serbia and the capital of the autonomous province of Vojvodina. Lying on the banks of the Danube river, the city faces the northern slopes of Fruška Gora mountain. Throughout history, Novi Sad was a centre of culture that gathered poets, painters and many other artists, being referred to as 'Serbian Athens'. Today, Novi Sad is a home of EXIT, one of the most popular music festivals in Europe that brings together musicians from around the world. Due to its historical significance and great potential to develop even more, Novi Sad was proclaimed the European Capital of Culture for the year 2021!



IN NOVI SAD

CHURCH OF THE NAME OF MARY

is one of the most recognisable buildings in Novi Sad. 'The Cathedral', as locals call it, is situated in the city center on the Liberty square. What represents this particular church is its neo-Gothic style, stained-glass windows and a 72m-high tower, which you can undoubtedly see from any point of Novi Sad.



MUSEUM OF VOJVODINA

is a historically significant representative of material and spiritual culture from the entire territory of Vojvodina starting from Palaeolithic Age to the 20th century. It features the Collection of Applied and Visual Art with collections of period furniture, clocks and pictures, paintings, prints, sculptures, tapestries and mosaics with numerous unique items.



PETROVARADIN FORTRESS

was a significant Austrian military fort during 17. and 18. century. Today it is city's cultural center, home to Exit festival and place with a very mysterious underground, appealing to explorers from around the world. It is considered to be a symbol of Novi Sad, known for its clocktower with a specific mechanism: its little clock-hand indicates minutes, while the big hand represents hours.



THE GALLERY OF MATICA SRPSKA

is connected with the history of Matica Srpska, the most significant cultural institution among the Serbs. Since the founding of the Gallery, number of items in its collection has significantly increased. Permanent exhibition of the Gallery of Matica Srpska, consists mainly of the pieces of Serbian painting and graphic from the 16th to 21st century.



CLOSE TO US



FRUŠKA GORA

is the oldest National park in Serbia. It is a unique place where you can find many beautiful Serbian Orthodox Monasteries, lakes, spas, diverse animal and plant species. However, what also brings tourists to this area are the most prestigious vineyards and their high-quality wine.

SREMSKI KARLOVCI

is a true jewel of Serbian history and spirituality. Other than its religious and cultural importance throughout the years, it is very well known for great wine. This is one of the most picturesque towns in Serbia's Vojvodina region, with its well-preserved baroque and neoclassicist architecture.



BAČ

is a town located about 60 km from Novi Sad. The most important landmark is the Bač Fortress, the best preserved medieval fort in Vojvodina. One of the first modern pharmacies in this part of Vojvodina was opened in Bač in 1828

KOVI LJ MONASTERY

is a 13th-century Serb Orthodox monastery, often referred to as one of the most beautiful ones. It was founded by Saint Sava, the first Serbian Archbishop. It is protected by the state as a cultural monument, because it is one of the most monumental cultural-historical objects in Bačka, Vojvodina.



FOOD TO TRY

TRADITIONAL CUISINE

Serbian traditional cuisine is a mix of influences from all around the region. Some of the most famous dishes are sarma (rolls of sour cabbage filled with mixed meat), gibanica (a special cheese pie), baked beans and Karadjordjeva schnitzel (roll of meat filled with ham and cheese).

PLACES: GREDA, SOKACE NEW WAY



INDEX SANDWICH

is an old tradition in Novi Sad and one of the first fast food specialties here. It is a grilled sandwich with meat, melted cheese filled with mushrooms and your own choice of toppings and salads. Who ever tried it - loved it!

PLACES: MIRJANA, MAJA, VANESA



KREMPITA

People from Serbia are well known for their unique tasty deserts. Kremplita would be roughly translated 'cream-pie'. It is made of very thin crusts and a thick layer of delicious vanilla cream between them. It simply tastes like heaven.

PLACES: ŠEHerezADA, VREMEPLOV



ČEVAPI

the famous 'cevapi' is a kind of grilled mixed meat shaped like small sausages. It is often served in a bun or with onions and known for its delicious smoky flavor.

PLACES: SARAJEVSKI, BANJALUČKI

KAFANA

What Serbia is well known for, besides amazing food and friendly people, certainly is unforgettable partying! The most unique place, which brings everyone together and represents the essential source of wonderful memories, is "kafana". There is no way to describe this warm, loving atmosphere until you see it for yourself.

PLACES: LAZIN SALAŠ, RIBAR



ROCK GIGS

are the most enjoyable parties in the city. You can just sit back, drink your beer and enjoy the pleasant sounds of the guitar. You don't even have to know the songs to have great fun listening to them! If you want to have a nice, relaxing chat with your friends, over music and wine, this is the place for you!

PLACES: BRAUHAUS, GERILA BAR



OTHER FUN ACTIVITIES

If you are more of a sports type, you can have a blast in Novi Sad! The city is filled with playrooms where you can play pool, darts or table-hockey, or go bowling. Also, if you like board games, or maybe karaoke, Novi Sad has loads of places for you. Just gather up your crew, and have the time of your life!

CLUBBING

If you are in the mood for some classic party-time, the clubs are always ready for you! In kafanas you can hear only Serbian music, while clubs offer a wider range of genres and something more familiar to you. They are a bit more fancy, so if you feel like getting dressed up and partying hard, these are the places for you!

WHAT SEP PRACTICE IN NOVI SAD HAS TO OFFER

When SEP students come to Novi Sad, there are two options regarding their SEP practice.

The first one is Research, for those who are curious and avantouristic. The usual fields of research are: Pharmacology, Toxicological Chemistry, Organic and Physical Chemistry, Pharmacognosy...

The other option is, of course, well known Community pharmacy. This is a great way for students to experience working with patients, firsthand.



COMMUTING

The most common way of commuting in Novi Sad is by bus. Everything is very close near, and the frequency of bus traffic is very high. The entire city and its suburban areas are very well covered by this well organised network.



TECHNICAL DETAILS

WEATHER

In Serbia, the weather in July and August is quite nice for summer-lovers. Days are usually pretty hot, so you don't have to bring plenty of warm clothes, but nights can get chilly. However, be prepared for rainy, stormy days that are very common during summer. Pack for hot days with a minor chance of rain!

CURRENCY – SERBIAN DINARS

The Serbian dinar (RSD) is the official currency of Serbia. One dinar is subdivided into 100 para. For one euro you can get about 115 dinars.

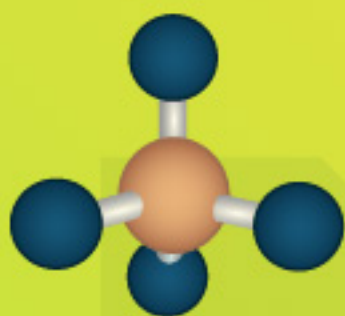
