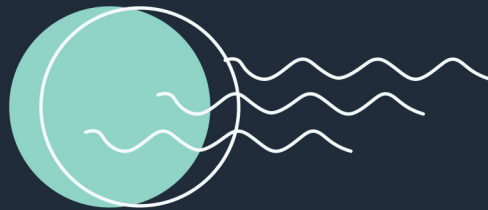
GREETINGS!

IDR or Indonesian rupiah is the currency of this country

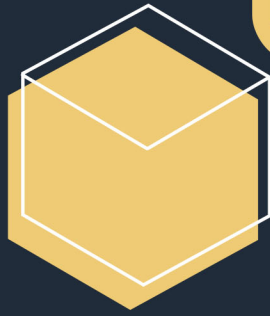
1 USD = Rp14.086,75 (February 2021)

We suggest you exchange your money before your arrival in Indonesia or you can do it at the airport or other money changer.

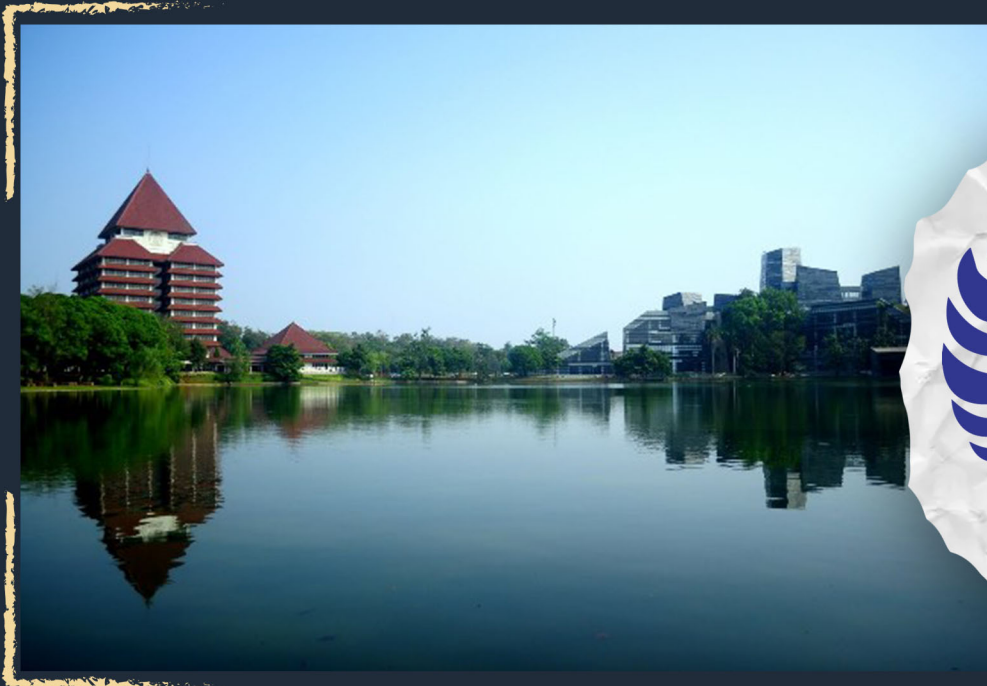
LANGUAGE

*) prevent the risk of pickpocketing and other unexpected crimes

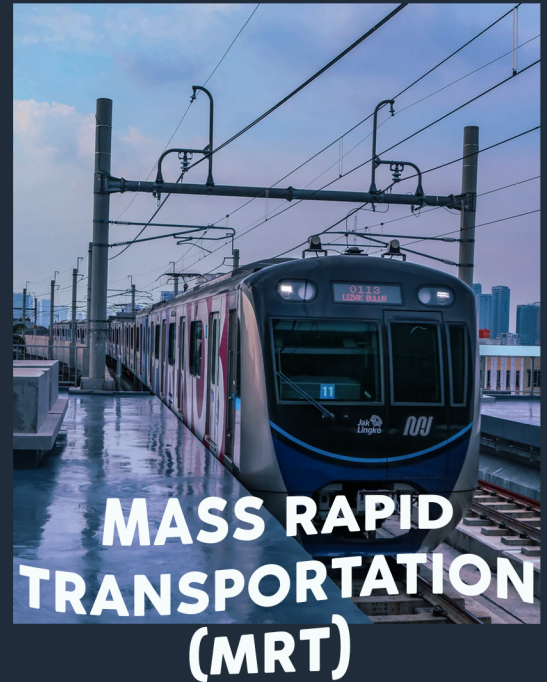
TRANSPORTATION

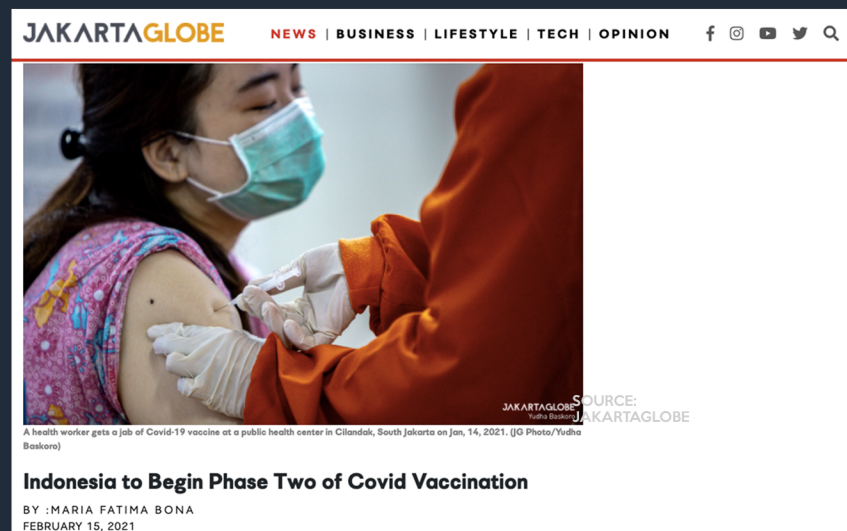

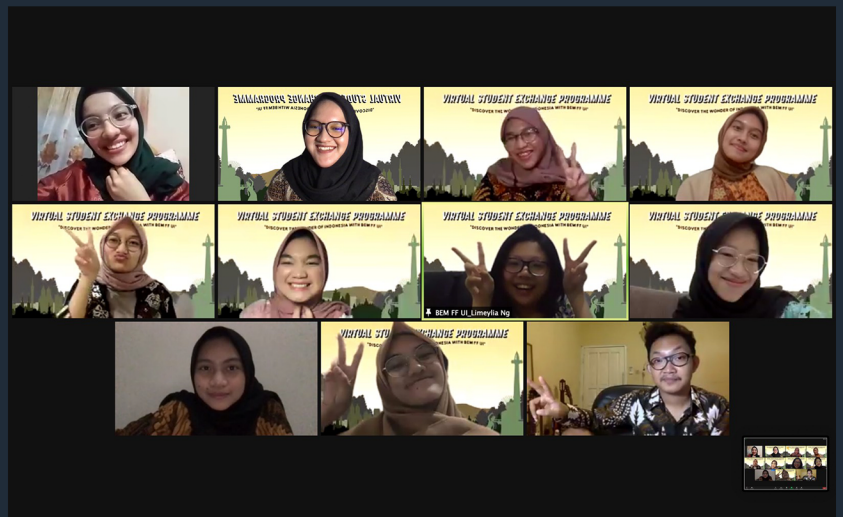
